Improve your personal safety strategies with NRA's Refuse To Be A Victim Program.

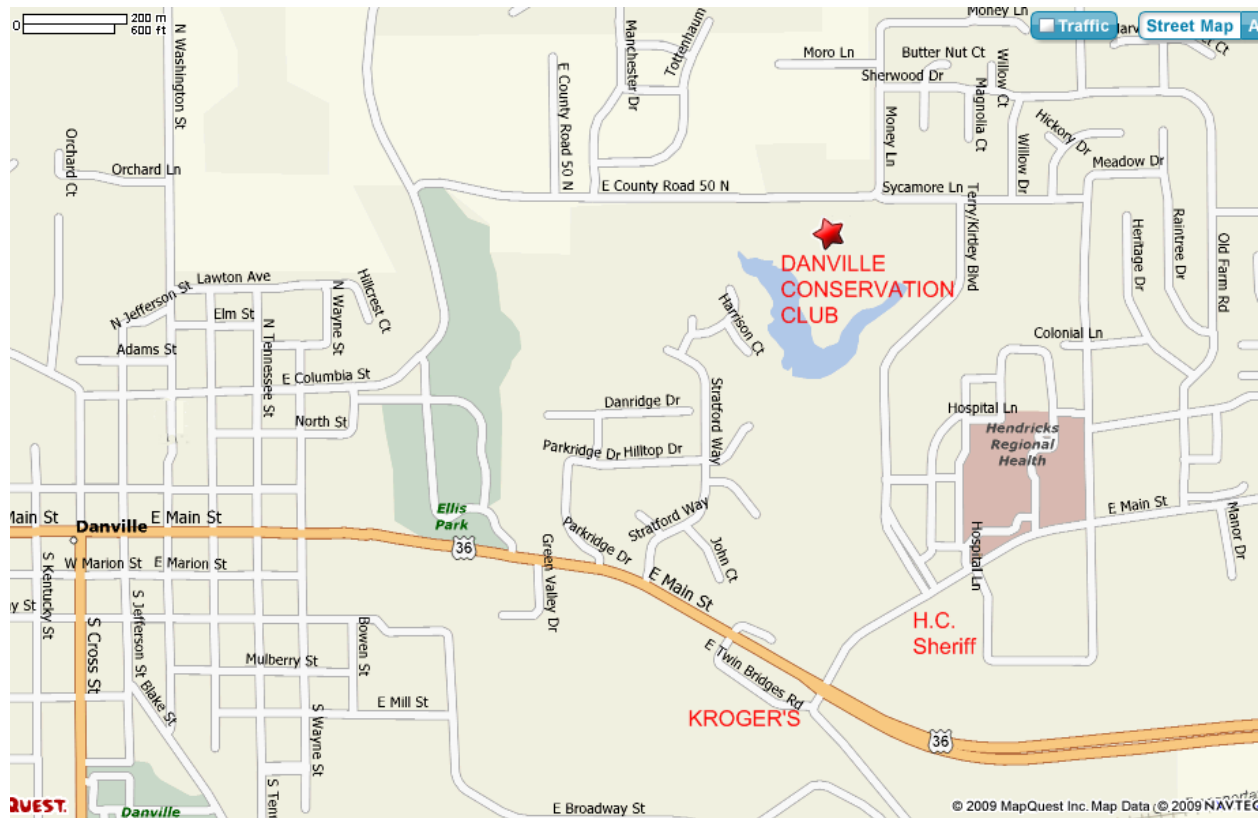
